In addition to his responsibilities as the Director of Testing Services, Mr. Buckley is an instructor in the Rutgers Professional Golf Turf Management School teaching courses in diseases and insect pests of turfgrass and ornamental plants. He is also a frequent lecturer and invited speaker on disease and insect pest problems in turf and ornamentals, plant problem solving, and pest management techniques.
